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## Post-Operative Instructions for Nasal Surgery

- 1. Take it easy for the rest of the day. No tub baths, showers or swimming on the day of discharge.
- 2. Elevate the head at all times. Sit in a recliner or use two to three pillows when sleeping. Head elevation reduces bleeding and swelling.
- 3. Do not drive or operate machinery for 24 hours. Do not engage in any strenuous activity, such as heavy lifting or exercise, for a period of at least two weeks.
- 4. Do not bend over. Bending increases the pressure around the surgery area and may cause bleeding. Keep the head elevated at all times.
- 5. Do not remove splints or packing. You may have to breathe from your mouth if the splints are occluded with mucous or clots. This may cause a dry mouth. Therefore, it is important to drink plenty of fluids.
- 6. Bleeding is expected for two to three days after surgery. Just change the drip pad as needed. It is not necessary to wear the drip pad during the entire post-op duration.
- 7. If you must sneeze, do so with your mouth open. Also, do not blow your nose. If excessive bleeding occurs, spray your nose with Afrin®.
- 8. Take all prescribed medications. Be sure to flush the nose with salt water. Please keep your scheduled post-op appointment.
